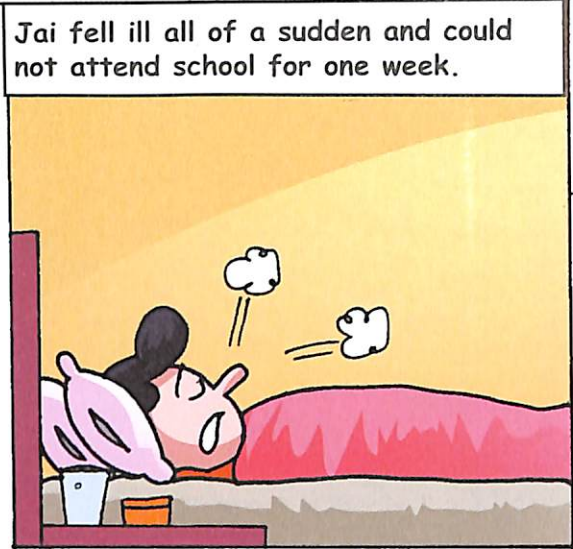


I would love to.

aloof in the school.

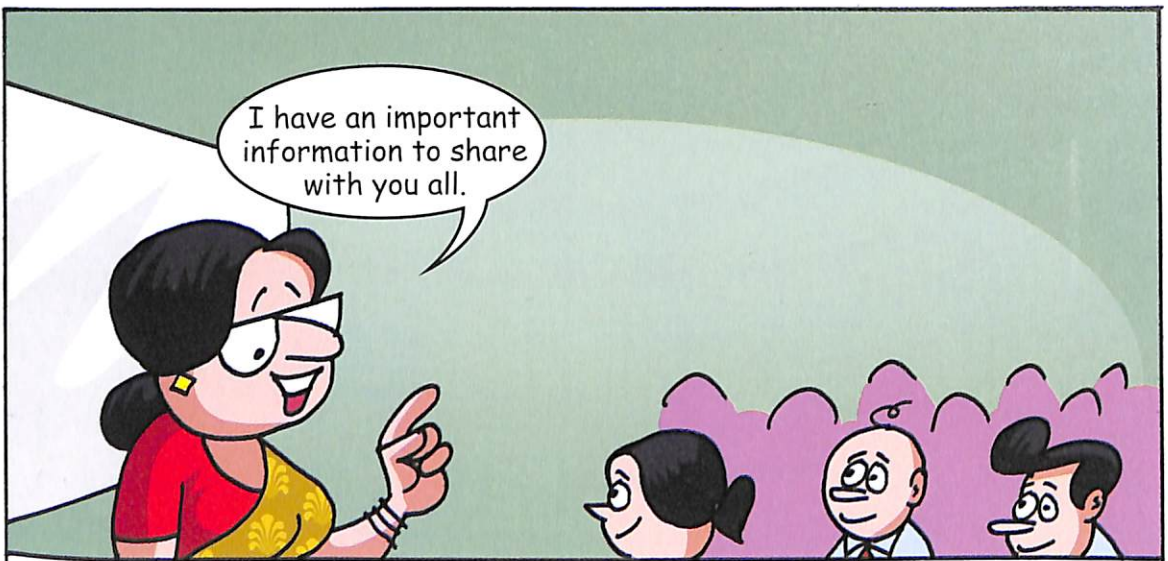






Next morning in the classroom.





We will be organizing a school event where every student is required to submit a science project in two weeks.



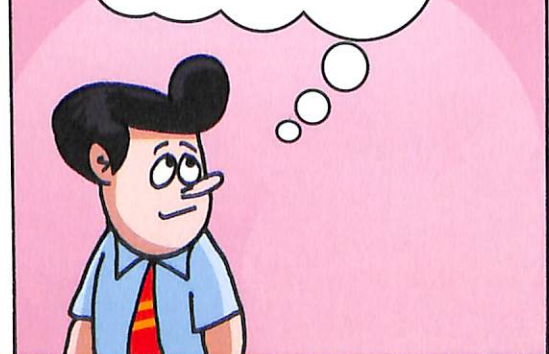
For this event the entire class will be divided into groups of three. Each group will have a leader from among themselves.



The teacher divided the class into teams of three and Jai was made the leader of his team which included Ruchi and Chander.

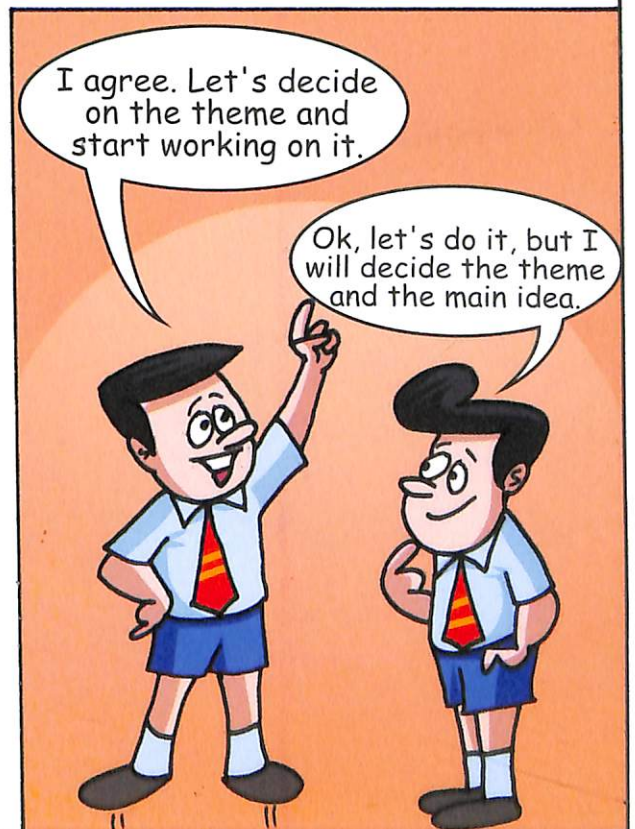


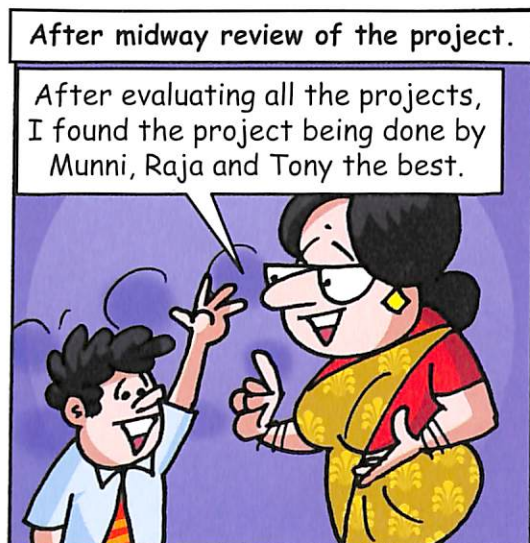
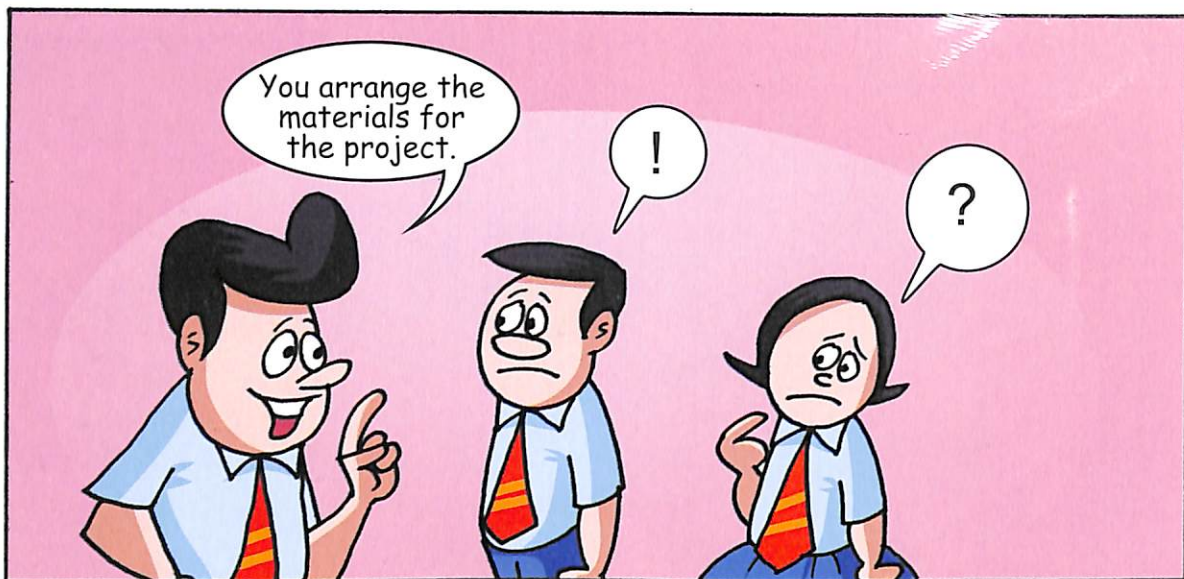
I can accomplish this project completely by myself and I don't need Ruchi or Chander.

I agree with Chander. If we work together in harmony, I am sure that our project can be the best.

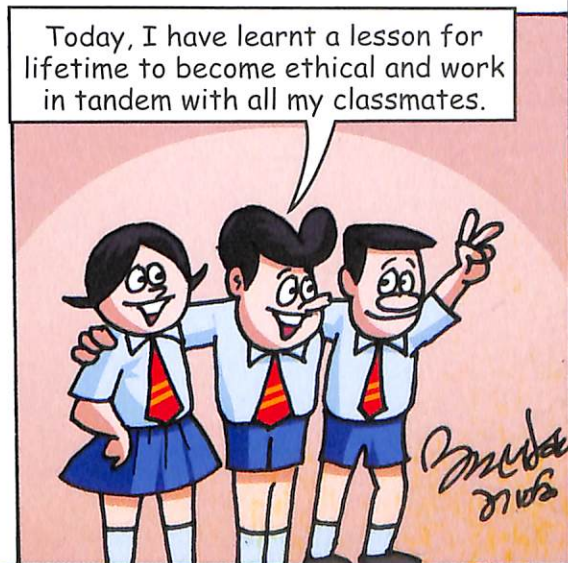
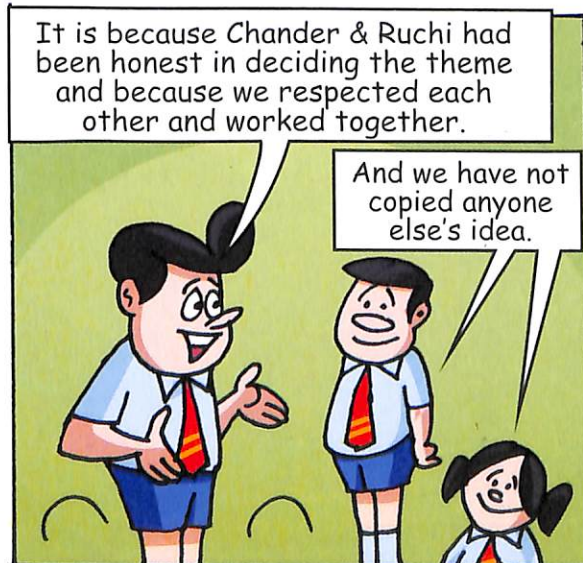
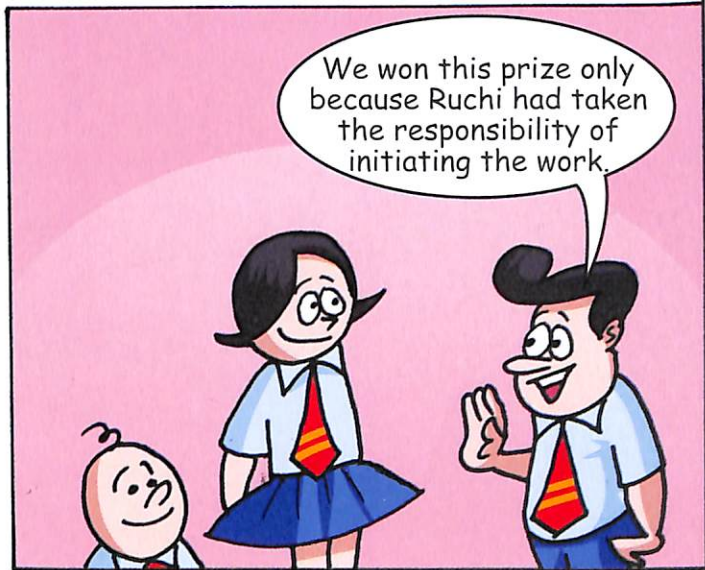
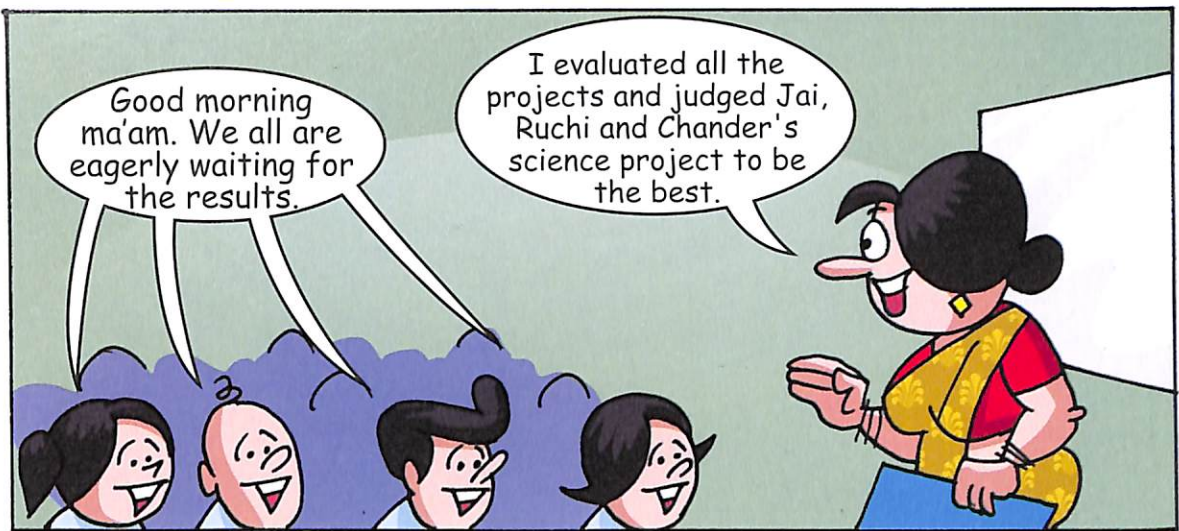
